

We offer two courses, a two-year course starting in April and a 1.5-year course starting in October. Students must have passed the appropriate Japanese proficiency level at the time of admission: N5 or N4, respectively.



# **Application Guidelines**

# **Eligibility**

☐ Students must have completed at least 12 years of school education or
equivalent at the time of admission to our school. (Students from
countries with school systems where the number of years of education
until graduation from high school is less than 12 years are still eligible to
apply. In such cases, the students must be eligible to apply to
universities in their home country.)
Ctudents must be at least 19 years of age

☐ Students must be at least 18 years of age.

☐ Students must have studied Japanese for at least 150 hours at schools, language teaching institutes, etc., before applying for admission.

□Students must be able to pay the costs of their study in Japan.

□ Students must have the motivation to study.

## Selection method

After submitting the application form, an interview will be conducted online. The interview will take about 40 minutes.

The questions will include the following: Checking Japanese language ability Confirming application requirements Confirming ability to pay expenses Motivation to study Thoughts on future plans, etc.

Admission will be determined based on the applicant's progress in learning Japanese and motivation to study.
